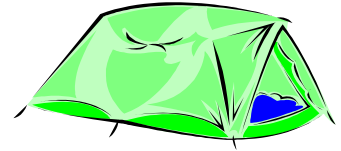




THE ADVENTURE BEGINS ~ JULY 4 -10, 2010

CAMP FRONTIER 2010



Now is the time to begin to plan for summer camp! It is NOT too early to check the dates and to put them on your calendar.

If you need shorts, scout socks, or other uniform parts, it is time to order them from Nankin Mills Fix-It Center on Ford Rd., or on Nine Mile, just east of Farmington Rd., or from The Scout Shop at Scout Headquarters (313) 898-8920, or from Scouting's National Supply Office at http://www.scoutstuff.org/bsasupply

Summer camp allows a boy to work/play at scouting all day for six days. All program features ~ swimming (in both the pool and lake), boating, archery, shooting, hiking, outdoor cooking, fishing, rappelling tower climbing, and waterfront zip line, as well as a wide variety of merit badge programs, will be operating at Camp Frontier this summer. Exciting programs for 2010 include Mountain Boarding, Action Shooting Range, and some 25 - 30 merit badge programs to choose from. They'll have mountain biking, a low COPE course and a horizontal climbing wall as well. Usually boys who attend summer camp stay active, advance up the scouting ladder, and get the most out of the program in #782.

The total cost for the week at camp is \$296, IF the TOTAL PAYMENT is made by May 3, 2010. The cost will be \$316 if the deposit is made after May 3, 2010. This fee will cover all but spending money, ammo on the rifle range, purchased handicraft items and some merit badge fees. Our troop will attend Camp Frontier (just over the Ohio border, south of Jackson, MI), the JOHNNY APPPLESEED SITE, July 4 - 10, 2010.

All scouts must attend the entire camp from Sunday through Saturday to participate in summer camp with Troop 782.

Physical examination form, camp map, equipment list and necessary information on advancement preparations will be given out in late April, after scouts sign up and pay for camp. We will take late camp registrants until the Court of Honor in June, but the Toledo Council charges the extra \$20 fee for each scout who is not paid in full by the due date of 5/03/10. Parents who register as a leader with the troop, and who have completed the Youth Protection Program are welcome to come for the week, or for at least three days. No adults will be able to come up for a day or two. If you can spend the week, or at least three days at camp, please contact Mr. Bill Dobson. The fee for an adult for the week is \$130, of which the troop will pay \$50. NOTE: All parents spending the full week, or three days & nights in camp will need a completed summer camp physical form, in addition to the adult registration with Troop 782, and the Youth Protection Program, - which can be completed online.

Scouts, who have been to summer camp before, know that they should begin deciding which merit badges they need to prepare for, and then get the merit badge books, begin reading and do the necessary requirements at home before they ever leave for camp. Contact any one of the troop leaders, if you need help, or want advice on what advancement is especially worthwhile at camp. It would be helpful if each scout has had an overnight camping experience - without a parent - before going to camp. Summer camp is especially important for all the newest scouts in the troop. It is a chance to get to know most of the rest of the guys, and to begin working on your advancement, without losing the whole summer.
